MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE KOREA RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND SCIENCE

AND

THE OFFICE OF ATOMS FOR PEACE (THAILAND)

AND

THE KOREA NUCLEAR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION
FOUNDATION

The Korea Research Institute of Standards, the Office of Atoms for Peace of Thailand and Science and the Korea Nuclear International Cooperation Foundation, (hereinafter referred to as the “Participants”);

AFFIRM the cooperative and friendly relationship existing between the Participants and believes that trilateral cooperation will further contribute to the development of the three Participants;

DESIRE to facilitate cooperation in the field of ionizing radiation metrology on the basis of the Agreement between the Participants;

ACKNOWLEDGE the mutual interest in the field of ionizing radiation metrology and BEING CONVINCED that a Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the “MoU”) can contribute to intensifying cooperation and that the cooperation will lead to the accomplishment of mutual benefits;

Have reached the following understanding:

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this MoU is to promote cooperation in the field of ionizing radiation metrology between the Participants and provide a framework for cooperation between the Participants on the basis of equality and mutual benefit. This MoU is not intended to be legally binding.

FORMS OF COOPERATION

Forms of cooperative activities under this MoU may include, but are not limited to:

- A. Development of joint research projects
- B. Exchange of research scientists and engineers
- C. Exchange of scientific and technical information
- D. Co-organization of seminars, symposia and conferences
- E. Other activities that may be agreed upon by the Participants

ARRANGEMENT OF RESOURCES

- A. Cooperative activities are to be done on the basis of mutual respect, in conformity with the laws and regulations in force in each Participant's country, within their respective available resources.
- B. The terms of financing will be agreed upon by correspondence between the Participants in advance of the commencement of activities.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Ownership and use of any scientific and technical information or other intellectual property created in the course of activities under this MoU will be subject to a prior written agreement between the Participants on a project-by-project basis.

ENTRY INTO FORCE AND TERMINATION

The MoU will come into effect on the date of signing. The MoU will be valid for an initial period of five (5) years and thereafter is automatically extended, unless a Participant gives notice to terminate it, with such notice to be given ninety (90) days' prior to the expiration of the five (5) year period. A Participant may propose an amendment by means of written notice to the other Participants, and the amendment will be in effect by the mutual written consent between the Participants.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective institutions, have signed this MOU.




