NOTIFICATION OF THE OFFICE OF ATOMS FOR PEACE
ON GUIDELINE FOR OFFICERS AT THE OFFICE OF ATOMS FOR PEACE
ON ASSESSING INDIVIDUAL DOSE RECORDS,
B.E. 2563 (2020)

To have a guideline for officers at the Office of Atoms for Peace on assessing individual dose records for nuclear and radiation safety regulation, by virtue of section 5, section 8, and section 14 of the Administration Act of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation, B.E. 2562 (2019), in conjunction with section 32, section 36, and section 37 of the State Administration Act, B.E. 2534 (1991), the Secretary General of the Office of Atoms for Peace hereby issues the Notification as follows:

An officer, who assesses documents accompanying applications and submitted documents for the benefits of nuclear and radiation safety regulation, can consider individual dose records from entities having the following qualifications:

1. Being certified under the Thai Industrial Standard on the General Requirements for the Competence of Testing and Calibration Laboratories, TIS No. 17025-2561 (ISO/IEC 17025:2017) on the scope of individual radiation dose measurement, and the evaluation of individual radiation dose measurement results shall be in accordance with the ISO 14146:2018 or other similar methods;

2. Passing the interlaboratory comparison exercise or the proficiency testing program organized by the entities certified under the conformity assessment in accordance with the ISO/IEC 17043:2010, or by national entities on ionizing radiation metrology or designated entities by the national metrology entity of the respective country.
