



Announcement of Office of Atoms for Peace
Subject: Declaration of Intent on the No Gift Policy
Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

The Office of Atoms for Peace (OAP), as the regulatory authority responsible for nuclear and radiation safety in Thailand, is committed to administering the organization in accordance with the principles of good governance, transparency, and accountability in order to build confidence among the public and all stakeholders, In order to comply with the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) criteria established by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC), and to support the implementation of the National Reform Plan on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), Reform Activity No. 4: “Developing the Thai Bureaucratic System to be Transparent and Free from Conflicts of Interest,” the Office of Atoms for Peace hereby declares its intentions as follows:

1. All executives, government officials, employees, and all personnel of the Office of Atoms for Peace shall neither accept gifts, gratuities, nor any other benefits arising from or related to the performance of their duties, whether before, during, or after the performance of such duties, which may result in corruption or misconduct at present or in the future. This measure is intended to prevent conflicts of interest and to strengthen a culture of integrity within the organization.

2. All personnel at every level shall strictly comply with this No Gift Policy declaration, and supervisors shall oversee and ensure that their subordinates comply with the aforementioned guidelines.

3. The Office of Atoms for Peace encourages service recipients and stakeholders from the public sector, private sector, and the general public to acknowledge and comply with the No Gift Policy guidelines by jointly expressing their intention not to give or receive gifts or gratuities related to official duties.

The Office of Atoms for Peace requests that all executives and personnel at every level strictly adhere to this declaration and jointly serve as role models in fostering a culture of transparency and ethical administration so that the Office of Atoms for Peace may truly become an organization of integrity and transparency.

This announcement is hereby issued for acknowledgment and compliance.
